

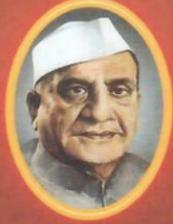



## Slow and Advanced Learners Policy

### Faculty and college responsibility towards slow learners

#### **Policy Statement:**

This policy applies to all faculty members and the college administration of Dhanwate National College, Nagpur.


#### **Definition:**

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
- f) Faculty members should encourage peer education strategies, such as implementing a buddy system or assigning peer mentors, to facilitate collaborative learning and support among students.

This policy applies to all faculty members and the college administration of Dhanwate National College, Nagpur.


#### **Definition:**

- Faculty members should encourage advanced learners to read research papers and make presentations before the class, promoting their ability to analyze complex information and articulate their ideas effectively.



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
