



Best practice 1: Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Krida Mahotsav (Sports Festival)

Title of the Practice:

Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Krida Mahotsav: Cultivating Holistic Development through Sports .Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Krida Mahotsava 2023 organized for the 23rd consecutive year. It was conducted between October 3-6, 2023. The sport of table tennis was newly included as it was the 125th centenary silver jubilee year of Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh. Under this, inter-college competitions are organized in Kabaddi, Volleyball, Badminton, Table Tennis, Chess, Korfball, (Boys/Girls), Basketball, Football and Cricket (Boys).Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Krida Mahotsav: Cultivating Holistic Development through Sports.

Objectives of the Practice:

1. **Promote Physical and Mental Well-being:** Encourage active participation in sports for a healthy lifestyle.
2. **Foster Team Spirit and Leadership:** Develop qualities like teamwork, resilience, and decision-making among students.
3. **Encourage Inclusivity:** Provide a platform for students from diverse backgrounds to come together and participate.
4. **Identify and Nurture Talent:** Spot potential athletes and provide them with opportunities for further growth.
5. **Instill Cultural and Ethical Values:** Integrate sportsmanship with cultural heritage and ethical principles.

The Context

- The institute observed a need to create a platform for students to engage in extracurricular activities to complement their academic pursuits.
- Rural and urban students lacked exposure to professional sports and structured competitions.
- There was a need to address lifestyle-related health issues among students.
- The festival was conceptualized to create an inclusive, competitive, and enjoyable environment for fostering holistic development.

The Practice

1. Event Overview

- The festival spans four
- days with various sports and athletic events, such as cricket, volleyball, kabaddi, athletics, chess, and cultural programs.
- Open to students from multiple institutions to ensure wide participation.

2. Execution:

- A dedicated **organizing committee** ensures smooth planning and management.
- Facilities such as sports grounds, equipment, and refreshments are arranged.
- Events are officiated by qualified referees and judges.

3. Inclusive Participation:

- Separate categories for men and women.
- Special initiatives for differently-abled students.

4. Support and Resources:

- Financial support is gathered through sponsorships and institutional funding.
- Local community involvement for logistics and hospitality.

5. Cultural Integration:

- Traditional games and cultural programs are integrated to promote heritage.
- Ethical and value-based workshops are conducted alongside sports activities.

Evidence of Success

1. Increased Participation:

- Over 1,000 students from 50+ colleges participate annually.
- Significant growth in female participation.

2. Talent Recognition:

- Several participants have excelled in inter-university, state, and national-level sports.

3. Impact on Health and Academics:

Grand Inauguration of Four Day Dr Panjabrao Deshmukh Krida Mahotsava: Dr. Sanjay Thackeray, Joint Director, Higher Education, Nagpur inaugurated the Krida Mahotsava on Tuesday October 3, 2023 at 5.00 pm under the chairmanship of Mr. Dilipbhau Ingole, Treasurer, Shri Shivaji Education Society, Amravati. Best Practice 2: Institutional Social Responsibility

- Positive feedback from stakeholders, including local communities, educational institutions, and partners, reflecting the program's impact.


Challenges and Resources:
