





BRIEF HISTORY

The college was founded by a group of public-spirited citizens who recognized the need for large opportunities for university education. It was started at Wardha in 1935 as Wasudeo Arts College, and shifted to Nagpur in 1942 and named as National college.

Shri Shivaji Education Society, Amravati, took over the management of this college in 1949. In 1951, Late Shrimant Dadasheb Dhanwate gave a donation of 60,000/- to the Society for Dhanwate National college.

The College is affiliated to Nagpur University, Nagpur since its establishment. It is in Maharashtra, having Arts and Commerce faculties upto Post-graduate imparting instructions in English and Marathi mediums and also conducting Postgraduate courses in certain allied disciplines, viz, PGDCCA, MCM, M.Com, M.A. (Mass Communication) & B. A. (Mass Communication) in Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Institute of Management Technology & Research. The college located in its sprawling building in Congress Nagar stands today as a living epitome of the realization of the dream of its founder Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh who was an erudite scholar of Sanskrit, Social reformer and educationalist. The motto of the college is सत्यं शिवं सुन्दरम् and the colours of the college flag are green, White and yellow.
