## Extra Coaching provided to sportsman for particular sports

**1** **Gymnastics Coaching Center :** We have been running Shivaji Gymnastics Club for the last eight years under the guidance of National Athletes Mr. Sanket Vinchurkar and Mr. Mayuresh Srishikar. The club offers free training to school children throughout the year, especially to students from even the poorest of the poor. Over the past year and a half, training has continued through online, even when the Corona epidemic has been locked down. But now the practice has started regularly and there are 50-60 trainees. **Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Badminton Academy :** The Badminton Academy was opened in May 2016 for the benefit of students undergoing regular training and for the purpose of producing international players. More than 250 students from inside and outside the college benefit from our coaching center. The morning session benefits doctors, engineers, lawyers, CAs and other professionals.



**Football Academy: -** Football Training - Along with other sports, a football training center is also run for those who need extra fitness. For this 40-50 players come to practice regularly. They are trained through coaches. The honorarium is paid to the trainer for the purpose of creating self-employment.



**Softball Coaching Center :** Softball coaching has been running on the college grounds for the last fourteen years in collaboration with the District Softball Association. More than 70 students from various schools and colleges come for training every day. Many of the players who have trained here have participated in state, national and international competitions.



**Table Tennis :**From last year college started regular coaching for students and players. The center is run with the help of Nagpur District Table tennis Association



**Chess Coaching Center :** Coaching on regular for students and players began working in association with Nagpur District Chess Association to organize various level tournaments

**Cricket ground with Turf Wicket:** Well maintained College Cricket Ground with turf wicket at Vasant Nagar, (16622.4 sqmt.) is available for players and to organise various tournament. Many players of our ground participated in VCA U/19, U/23 & Ranji Trophy.

**Sepak Takraw Training** - Sepaktakraw coaching has been started on the college grounds for the last five years in collaboration with the District Sepaktakraw Association.
